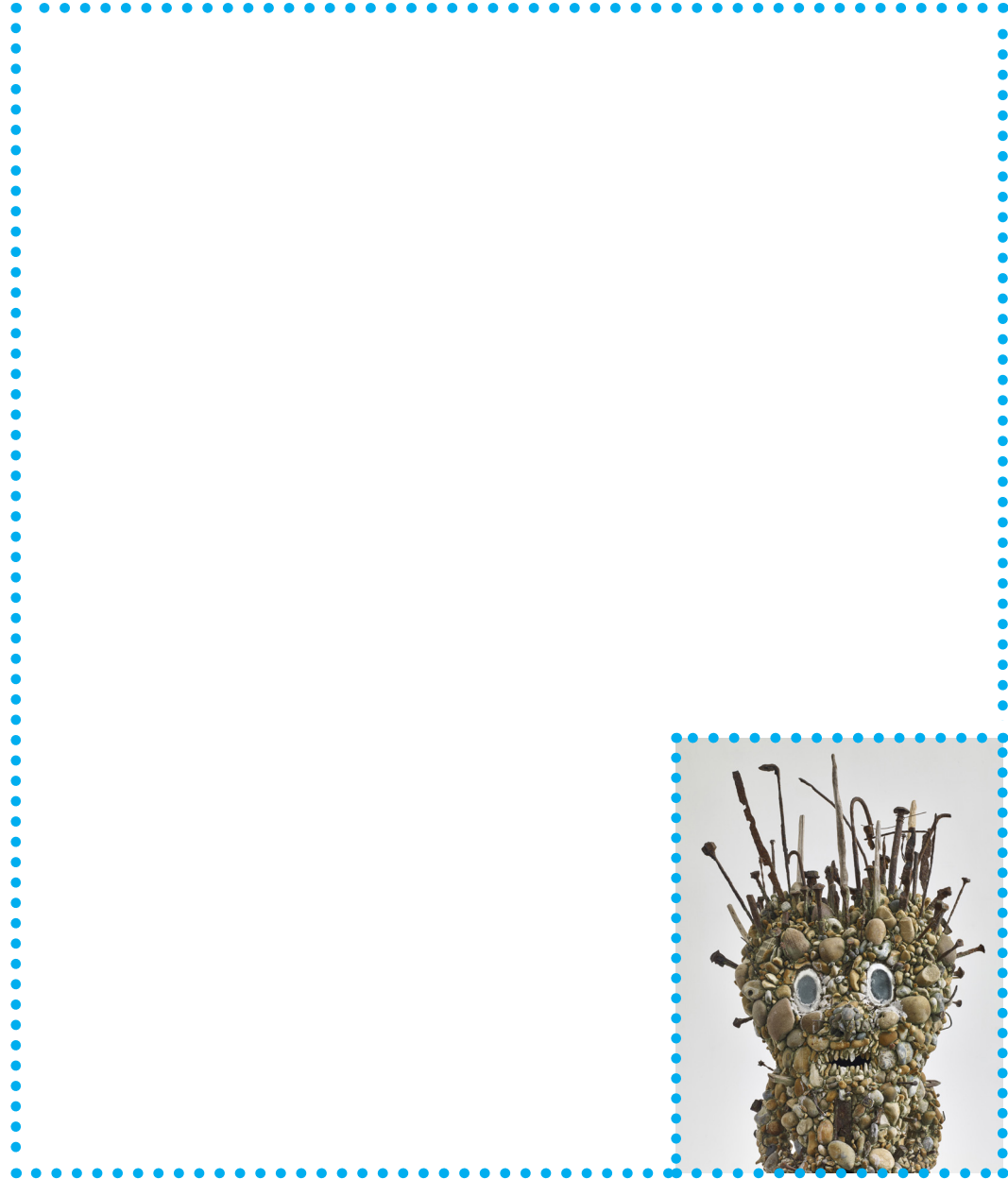
Make a Portrait with words
